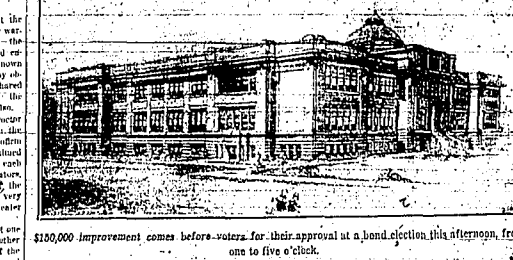

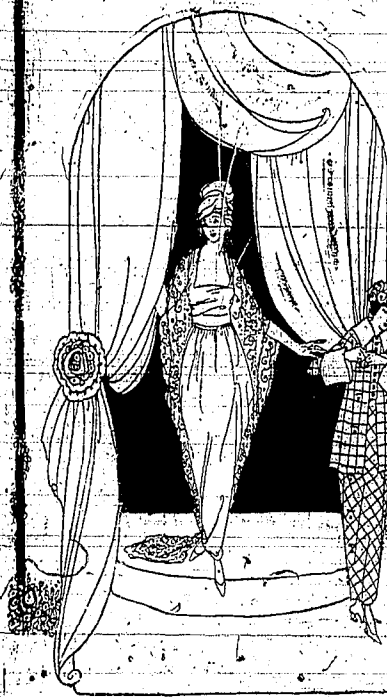

Military Slackers Will Be Prosecuted
 PORTLAND, Ore., April 12.—Federal officers are pursuing the trails of 115 alleged military slackers in Oregon, according to assistant United States Attorney Chas. W. Hixson today. He headed a group of slackers in Boston, Mass., and they followed with the end that he will be made to serve a year in jail and then be discharged, says the justice department.
 Out of 120 draft delinquents who were reported to the adjutant general, 100 have been charged as non-willful. The remainder are being investigated, and those who failed to report must accept their trial in the army, according to Attorney General Hixson.

JAPANESE LABOR TO FORM NEW PARTY
 TOKYO, March 10 (by mail)—Quite a bit of steady labor activity is becoming one of the new factors in the politics of Japan, and the formation of a labor party is generally expected to take place soon.
 Among the reasons for the formation of such a party (there are two) are: First, it is contended that Japan should have a labor party as the result of the great industrial revolution now going on and, secondly, it

is claimed that such a party provides the only means whereby universal suffrage can be obtained, as the existing political parties are too conservative. There are several names mentioned as possible leaders of the new party, but the two most widely mentioned are Baron Goto and Yuki, Oaki. Both these, according to the Japanese papers, entertain the ambition of becoming the labor leader of Japan. Baron Goto is now in the United States to make an investigation of political and social conditions there, and upon his return he will organize a labor party.
 It is also reported that Oaki, veteran chairman of the Kenesawee practical resignation from that party has occasioned much political comment, will make a foreign tour. When Oaki was mayor of Tokyo he opposed universal suffrage, but more recently

his views have completely changed. In an interview, he said: "I have made to my mind to exert myself for the cause of universal suffrage in co-operation with most progressive and national war heroes. That the public does not listen to me and I must find my co-workers among the thousands of laborers of Japan. By the labor I do not mean the common workers alone, as I think that officials, business men and others, who work with their brains, are likewise laborers."
 Japan would have at least 10,000,000 franchise holders under universal suffrage, and Japan needs universal suffrage, because she must become more democratic, while she claims for herself a membership in the league of nations. Oligarchy and autocracy must go forever, and national politics must hereafter be open to the public.

Teach Crippled War Heroes
 PHILADELPHIA, April 12.—Educational courses will be offered crippled and maimed war heroes at the school of occupational therapy, University of Pennsylvania. Donations of the school of education has announced. Courses will cover a period of four months.
