Spend Millions to Hold Australian Fighting Men

MELBOURNE, Australia, March 12.—More than 15,000 men have been sent by the state of Victoria to the purchase of land for settlement. During the month of February the state bought 71,120 acres of "tiltland" land for its future coming history.

The Queensland settlement committee has issued a report showing that out of 414,411 acres of land made available by the state for settlement, 147,000 returned soldiers have taken holdings aggregating 21,000 acres.

LONDON, March 12. (By mail)—Commercial aviation, despite rapid advances during the war in construction of powerful Zeppelins, aeroplanes and dirigibles, is not making headway from the ground up, and progress is expected to be comparatively slow in the old world. In the case of dirigibles, progress has been retarded by the destruction of the dirigible "Zeppelin," which was destroyed by a British Zeppelin, from which one would expect that dirigibles, trained and well equipped, were destined for a early demise and a junk heap.
