ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF WATER WORKS OF THE CITY OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF HIS APPOINTMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS OF HIS OFFICE AND THE COMPENSATION WHICH HE SHALL BE RECEIVING; THE SCHEDULES OF FEES AND DUES; PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE AND GOVERNANCE OF THE WATER WORKS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT UPON VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF ANY OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Creation of the Position of Waterworks Superintendent.

The Mayor shall have the power to appoint and remove the Superintendent of Water Works who shall hold office until the Monday next succeeding the expiration of the term of his office as provided for in this ordinance as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Duties of Waterworks Superintendent.

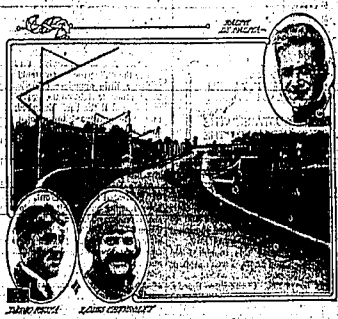

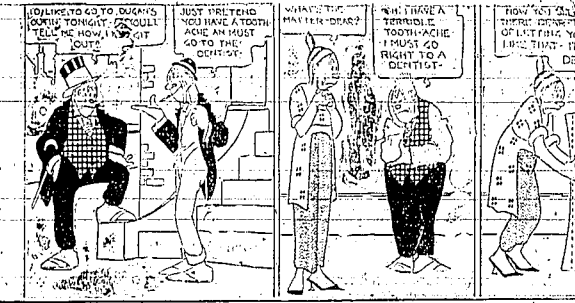

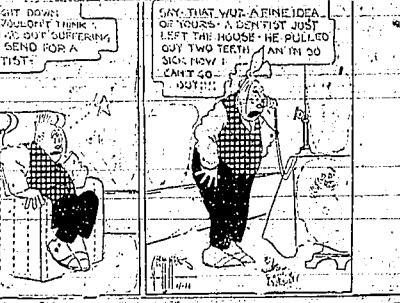
