

OPEN RUPTURE HAS COME IN CONFERENCE ORLANDO AND DR. CRISPI GOING TO ROME

PEACE CONFERENCE THREATENED WITH DISRUPTION THROUGH ITALIAN TERRITORIAL CLAIM OF ADRATIC PORT

(By the International News Service)

The first actual break in the peace conference negotiations came today with the Italian delegation planning to leave for Rome because of President Wilson's statement.

President Wilson has the solid support of Premier Lloyd George and Premier Clemenceau in his stand on Italian demands. Japan is openly supporting Italy and is threatening to withdraw from the conference unless her territorial claims in China are met.

The German delegates may attempt to take advantage of the dissensions among the allied and associated powers to further her colonial claims, but assurances were given today that she would meet with failure.

The allied press has taken a diverse stand on President Wilson's statement, some supporting and some attacking it.

PRESIDENT'S FUME STATEMENT IS DENOUNCED NO COMPROMISE IS POSITION OF THE ITALIANS

PARIS, April 24.—Powerful efforts were made today to solve the Italian problem which was brought to a head by President Wilson's statement that Fiume should be made a free port.

Premier Lloyd George and a representative of Premier Clemenceau held a long conference with President Wilson this morning. Later Premier Lloyd George reported to President Wilson and Premier Clemenceau to meet Premier Orlando this afternoon to take steps to prevent an actual break.

The Italian premier issued a statement replying to President Wilson's announcement and declaring that he would leave Italy's interests in the hands of the British and French prime ministers.

"Premier Orlando plans to return to Rome at once, but it is understood that the other members of the Italian peace mission will remain in Paris for a few days at least."

"Fiume is said to be coming high in honor and glory have been taken by the Italian government to guard the American embassy and consulates."

President Wilson did not act independently in making his statement. He has the support of both England and France. His announcement was submitted to both Premier Lloyd George and Premier Clemenceau before it was made public.

"On the other hand, before it was sympathetic to wards Italy and is threatening to follow Italy in withdrawing from the peace conference if the allies follow President Wilson's lead and refuse to accede to the demand for Chinese territory."

At Italian headquarters it was rumored that there could be no compromise. At the same time Premier Orlando issued his statement attacking President Wilson. The Italian premier denounced the appointment of an advisory to Italy in view of the agreement already reached in the past of London. Premier Orlando and Dr. Crispi of the Italian delegation will leave for Rome before the end of the day, it was said. They will be followed on Saturday by former Premier Salandra and Dr. Barzani, for many years champion of Italian irredentism in the Italian chamber of deputies.

It was denied in American circles that President Wilson will not budge from the stand he has taken, no matter what developments may be. At the same time the Italians say that Premier Orlando will stick to his determination to take a "heroic course."

In his message to Premier Clemenceau announcing the withdrawal of the Italians from the conference, Premier Orlando said that President Wilson's statement had "precluded any further participation in the conference by the Italians impossible."

There is an atmosphere of deep anger at Italian headquarters and the president is accused of a great breach of diplomatic etiquette.

FRANCE AND BRITAIN ARE IN ACCORD WITH PRESIDENT'S POLICY

Any Efforts of Germany to Make Political Capital Out of Break Will Meet With No Success—Wilson Will Interpret Fourteen Principles If They Attempt to Drag Them Into Argument.

PARIS, April 24.—France and Great Britain are fully in accord with President Wilson's publicly announced position on the Italian-Jugo-Slav territorial dispute and any attempt by the German peace delegates to make capital out of the temporary break will meet with no success, it was declared today by the British and French governments in a joint statement on the fourteen principles. President Wilson will interpret them himself.

The president's statement was prepared three days ago with the approval of Premier Lloyd George and Premier Clemenceau. It was so worded several hours before it was made public, and the two premiers were asked for suggestions.

"It is admirable in every way and I would not change a word of it," Premier Clemenceau is said to have remarked.

There is no apprehension among the American delegates as to the effect the statement will have in Italy. But in official circles some fears were expressed for the American role in Italy. Practical 100,000 of the American troops are out of Italy, but there are many French warships in that country yet.

ITALY WILL NOT GIVE UP FIUME

Washington, April 24.—Premier Orlando of Italy did not know in advance of the preparation of the president's statement. When a copy was handed to him, he said: "I am not in a position to discuss the subject of the highest interest. I cannot discuss it while it is translated into Italian and I have a desire to express all my views with my colleagues. Later we shall decide whether we will answer it with words or deeds. I am here representing the Italian people and therefore I am only able to speak when I am certain that I reflect their sentiments. In any event I cannot be drawn into a discussion which might give the false impression that there is a split between President Wilson and the Italian government."

President Orlando will remain in Paris as a result of the Italian declaration. The rest of the Italian delegation is expected to leave for a few days, according to news from a British source.
