# INDEPENDENCE OF LITHUANIA RECOMMENDED

WASHINGTON, April 26.—President Wilson was today urged to direct "immediate and serious consideration to the claims of the Lithuanian people for independence and the right of self-determination, and to request recognition by the United States of the present regime as the provisional government of Lithuania.

This action was taken by the American agricultural association, which in a 400-word telegram to the president also urged the withdrawal of the geographic limitation of the Kingdom of Lithuania existing at the time of the political union of that country with Poland in 1920.

The officers of the association responded, the cable stated, that "acting officials of the present provisional government can safely be depended upon to effectively meet and successfully combat the menacing menace of anarchy if the proper moral and material support is promptly extended them" by the United States and the allied nations.

## Will Travel to Coast in "Hotel" on Wheels

Touring in your own hotel is a new morning idea which Mr. Charles H. Barry, president of the Indiana Truck Corporation, Muncie, Ind., is responsible for.

Mr. Barry and his wife, Mrs. Harry (Goldwhite) and his wife, this spring will make a 40,000 mile trip to California and back in a "hotel" built upon a touring Indian truck chassis, mounted upon pneumatic tires.

Built into the chassis is a sleeping room for five people, including the driver. There is a kitchen and complete cooking apparatus, a small living room, a hall 20 inches wide between the sleeping compartments and a lighting system for lighting up at night, which comprises 20 or 25 electric lights. The truck is also equipped with lavatory and toilet, lock, picks, shavers, a powerful search light for the driver's seat, clothing chaps, etc.

The truck also has a refrigerator for preserving and keeping cool and it will hold a large quantity of food. Water is also to be cooled by special device in the refrigerator. The sleeping compartments for each person are 16 inches wide, with light and half mattresses. The top of the truck is equipped with a canopy like a boat-like army truck, and one side of this canopy is of sufficient length so it can be stretched to the ground, then staked part into it, and made into a regular tent.

There is also a space provided in the "hotel" for a motorcycle, for use of the driver on special excursions, taking him off the main line of travel. The truck, in addition to being equipped with pneumatic tires, has shock absorbers and snubbers, and Mr. Barry states that without pneumatic tire equipment, such a trip would not be possible. The standard wheel base of the truck has been lengthened to provide for the equipment.

## TRIBUTE OF PRIDE IN DEATH HELD SACRILEGE

LAKEWOOD, Ohio, April 26.—Pride, heathenism, distinction—in death? That thought alone is a Christian sacrilege, much less the dead itself.

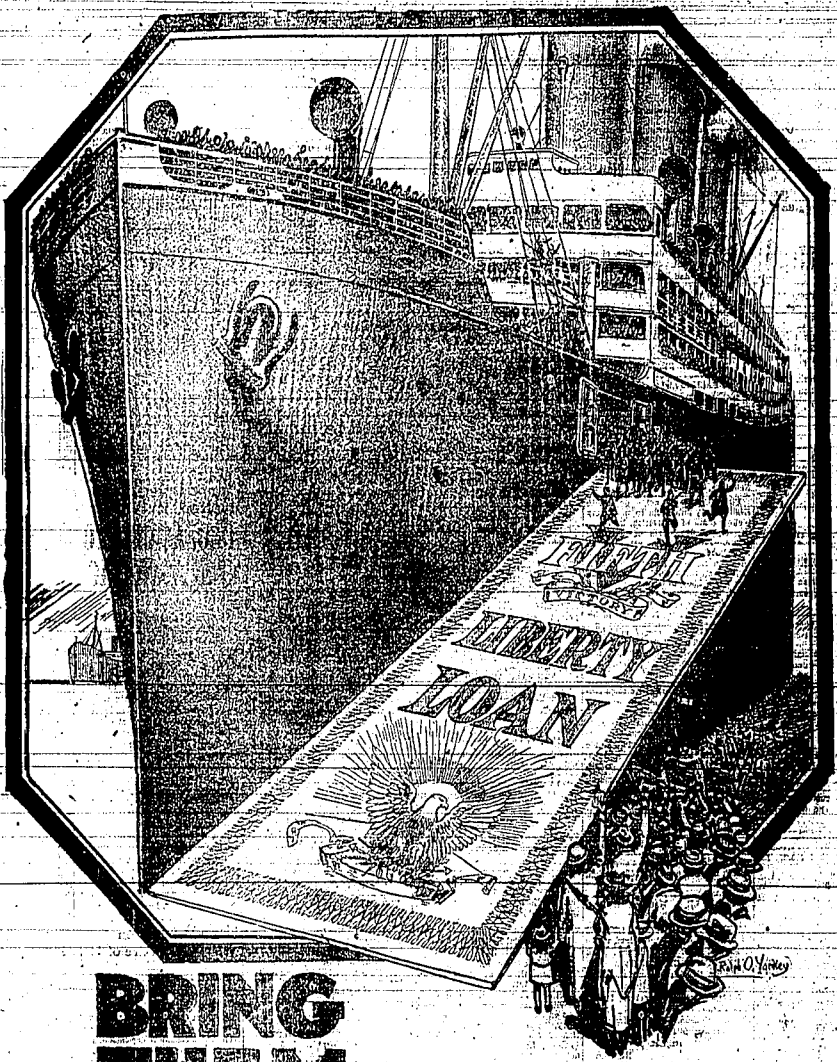
