# BREAKS UNDER HEAVY STRAIN

### "Insanity Evidence" in Murder Trial Tends to Show New Mentally Deficient

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 30.—Mrs. Lillie M. Herndon, slain today as the result of the terrific strain imposed upon her by constant attendance at the trial of her son, Henry S. Now, Jr., alleged son of United States Senator Now, of Indiana and confessed slayer of his sweetheart, Freda Lesser.

Her attending physicians say her condition is severe, but not serious.

She was pitched from the witness stand as a sensation today, when, lived by the minds of others until, a sudden blast of blind fury, he ran amuck and killed his sweetheart, Freda Lesser.

Several witnesses told how in their experiences he could be made to say and do almost anything by the process of subtle suggestion.

Such was the burden of "insanity evidence" submitted by the defense.

District Attorney Woolwine preferred to combat this, as it was in line with the defense theory that Now was incapable of discrimination between right and wrong.

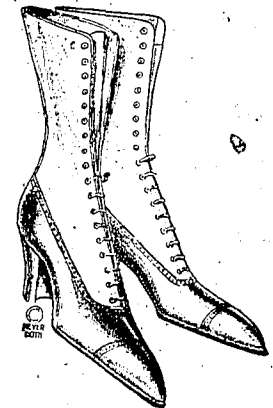

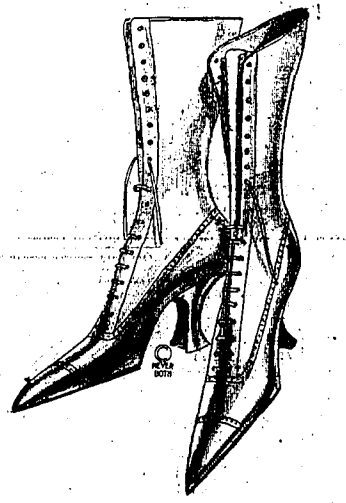

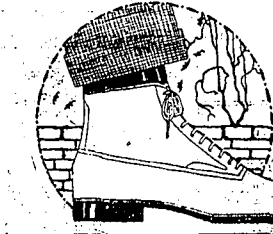

Verdict of Shooting of Man in Automobile Continues to Baffle Sleuths
