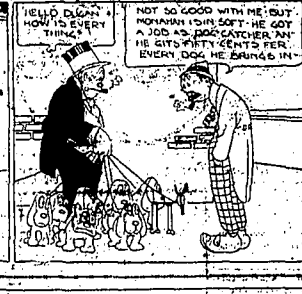
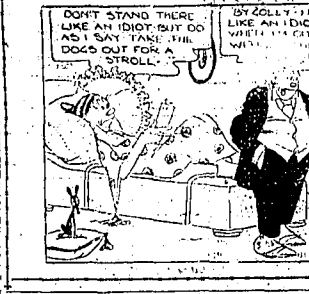

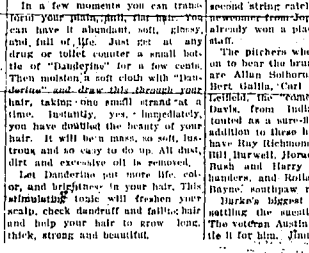

FINANCE SITUATION

Exports of Gold From Europe Are Rescuing Foreign Exchange Market Here

NEW YORK, March 5.—Immediate relief in the international financial situation was seen by bankers here today in the report that Europe will soon begin shipments of gold to the United States aggregating \$20,000,000. Coincident with the report came word that gold exports to South American countries are nearly at an end.

The report of the gold imports brought an abrupt rise in the foreign exchange market, demand for sterling which closed last night at 34 1/2 being noted today at the opening from 36 1/2 to 38 1/2.

A permanent improvement in the exchange situation is looked for, J. H. Patton of the National City Bank announced.

The scheduled fair weather spell may last for several days, the local weather forecast predicts.

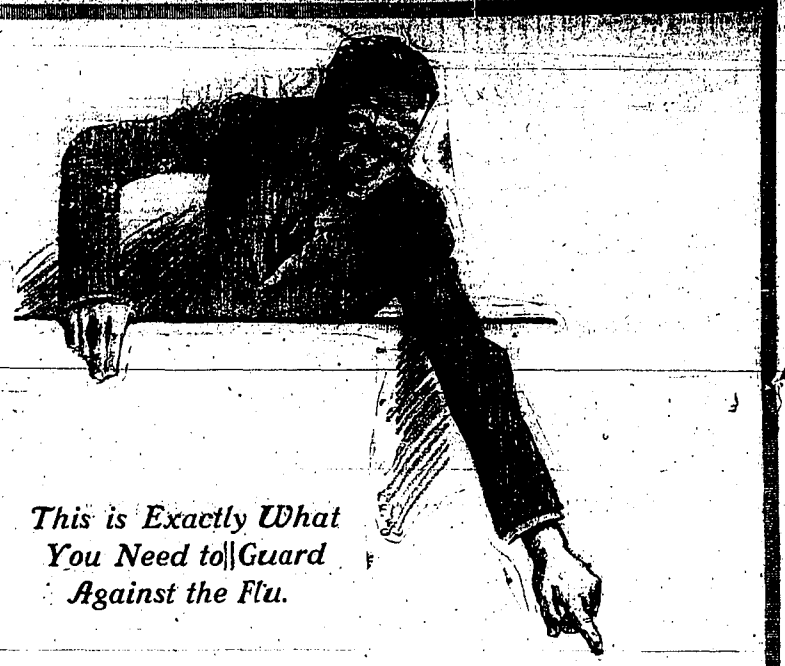
