### THE GREATEST PUBLICITY DRIVE

Have you noticed how all the papers that lay claim to be conservative, all American, labor-made friends of the farmer, are participating in another of those national campaigns to rot the farmer under the guise of protecting him? Last year haven't given it the attention it deserves we wish to point out its main features.

The great interests are short of cheap labor. We haven't had any immigration to speak of for four years. The publicity agency for the Du Pont interests tell us that the country is short about 4,000,000 unskilled workers. The only other source of this much wanted cheap labor is our rural surplus. So for over a year we have been treated to stories of silk-shirted stock cleaners, carpenters in top hats, machinists going to work in six-cylinder cars, and railroad employeering in wealth for almost no-walk-at-all. This is the bait for the rural suckers, for when the rural worker goes to the city he gets the wages and the conditions, not of the skilled worker but of the immigrant.

This is not all there is, however, to this greatest publicity drive undertaken by the dark forces in America since the war. The same stuff, in face of the market drops which the farmer has experienced tends to lead him into thinking that in some way city labor is to blame for hard conditions and thus interferes with that growing alliance between farmer and workman against the common enemy.

The controlled press is advertising the farmer workers away from the farm by laying stories and statements. At the same time it is cleverly trying to deprive the farmer of his one hope of improving his condition. This paper has not participated in the campaign to "defeat" the farmer in this style because it is not drawing its sustenance from special privilege.

Even if city labor were really prosperous, a paper that was working for the farmers would keep quiet about it. It would not constitute itself an enemy of the city employes.

### SHADE TREES IN GROUPS

An article in the monthly bulletin of the California department of agriculture urges more artistic grouping for trees planted along the public highways. "Because trees have been set in stiff, exact rows along the roadway for ages, the possibility of there being any better or different way is apparently never thought of," says the bulletin.

According to this authority the planting of trees should be in the hands of capable landscape gardeners, and the suggestion is made that the trees in each group be of one kind, with intervals of perhaps fifty to two hundred feet between the different clumps. This is the way nature plants trees. She does not set them out in long, stiff rows. It is suggested, too, that the roads will dry off better afterwards and snows that if shaded throughout their entire length which little grove will offer delightful shade to the traveler who wishes to rest and look about.

There is much to be said for this more artistic planting of trees. It would certainly tend to beautify the landscape, and it offers great possibilities in familiarizing the public with many different varieties, both native trees and those from other regions.


