Five Days Allowed Petitioners to File citations and for Answer

With completion of closing arguments in the canal election dispute, the case was taken under advisement by District Judge Babcock this morning, five days being allowed the petitioners to file citations of legal authority in support of their claims and for the defense to make its answer. The outcome of the controversy will therefore, be reserved until the middle or latter part of next week.

The final chapter of the hearing today was marked by a masterful presentation of the legal and moral issues involved, by Attorney Turner K. Hackman for the petitioners. In summing up his case Hackman reiterated the chief purpose of the petition as seeking a settled basis of conducting elections, rather than to upset the present or ganization or to develope friction. He met what he termed arguments of "expediency rather than with counter argument that the law provides just and equitable methods of conducting elections that are as simple and practical as the present system and that a change will not pro-duce entangling complications. These provisions duce entangling complications. These provisions he outlined to the court, also declaring that the problem had long vexed the farmers and that they were seriously and sincerely interested in getting a permanent interpretation rather than in seating any certain directors on the present board. The inference that there was any effort to align the farmer as a class against the city resident, he denounced as a figment of imagination and pointed out that the conduct of his case had at all-times indicated a desire to avoid fric-

Hackman accused the defense of evading the eal issue by arguing that the present system was the only practical one and that the defense wel comed any solution of the problem by the court.
