HARDING OFFICIALLY TODD PROPAGATION

DECLARATION OF PEACE IS ONE PROMISE

New Effort to Form Association of All Nations Based on Justice is Chief Note in Harding's Speech; League of Nations is Scored.

Popular Government to Be Reestablished
No Man is Big Enough to Run This Great Republic, Declares G. O. P. Nominee

MARION, O., July 22.—Immediate declaration of peace and a new effort to form an association of all nations based on justice rather than force, was promised by Warren G. Harding in formally accepting the republican presidential nomination here today.

Scoreing the league of nations opponent as the "supreme blunder," he characterized the senators who opposed its unequal ratification as "traitors to the nation." The nominee was silent regarding ratification of the treaty of the league in the event, however, he said he welcomed a referendum.

Harding opened his address with a tirade against "personal, dictatorial and autocratic government." He said "the people are entitled to run their own government."

"We continued to thank Thy servant, whom a large proportion of our citizens is calling to leadership, through the different days, ahead."

MILITANTS AT MARION PIQUED

Harding Gets Drop on Delegation by Issuing His Appeal on Eve of Arrival

MARION, O., July 22.—Militant republicans swooped down on Warren G. Harding today somewhat "upset" because the candidate issued his appeal for action on suffrage by the Tennessee legislature on the eve of their arrival. Militants had not counted on this sudden move by Harding but they went through with their program anyway and under the auspices of the league of nations.

One hundred women, members of the national women's party representing 15 states, marched in procession carrying banners up to Harding's front porch headed by Alice Paul, national chairman, Mrs. F. C. Miller of Mississippi, was in charge of the delegation.

Mrs. John Gordon Hattell, president of the Ohio women's republican club, introduced the two speakers, Miss Sue S. White, Tennessee, state chairman of the national women's party, and Mrs. H. C. Hays, governor of New York.

LODGE DENOUNCES LEAGUE OF NATIONS IN MARION SPEECH

MARION, O., July 22 (U.P.).—Henry Cabot Lodge today in his speech attacking Warren G. Harding of his nomination for president denounced the league of nations covenant as submitted by the president as "another name for the evil combination which has oppressed a hundred years ago by the highest of living men in our history and which he has not yet abandoned."

"It is not for us to curate and curate to you that I look to set forth the proper relation of the league of nations to our country both in the campaign and when charged with the responsibility of administration and legislation."

Praises Harding.—Lodge spoke at length on the league of nations, praising Harding for his courage in accepting the nomination in the face of the league of nations as written.

TENS THOUSANDS GATHER FOR DEDICATION PROGRAM

Will H. Hays Presides as Chairman; Special Trains Run to City and Auto Loads of People Pour in During the Day; Harding Greets Each Delegation as It Arrives; Suffragists on Hand to See Nominee.

MARION, July 22.—Senator Warren G. Harding was to hold today the dedication of the new stadium at Marion, O., which is to be named in honor of the republican national convention and the candidate.

Some ten thousand people were to be exchanged in the presence of some 5,000 neighbors, friends and distant relatives of the Harding family, according to the committee appointed by the republican national convention and the candidate.

It was a great day for Harding's home town. From all over Ohio and from many distant states the patriotic came. They poured out of every train and moved in cheering crowds through the city decorated streets to the Harding home for a glimpse at the man who had been elected to the White House.

Auto loads came in over every road and early in the forenoon they had packed the narrow streets until it seemed the place could hold no more.

Over thirty special railroad trains were run in and so many extra trains.

Visitors passed through a entrance as they entered Marion avenue and passed behind the curtain of heat or constructed by local friends in front of the Harding home.

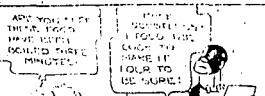

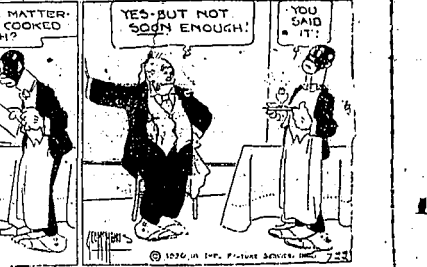
