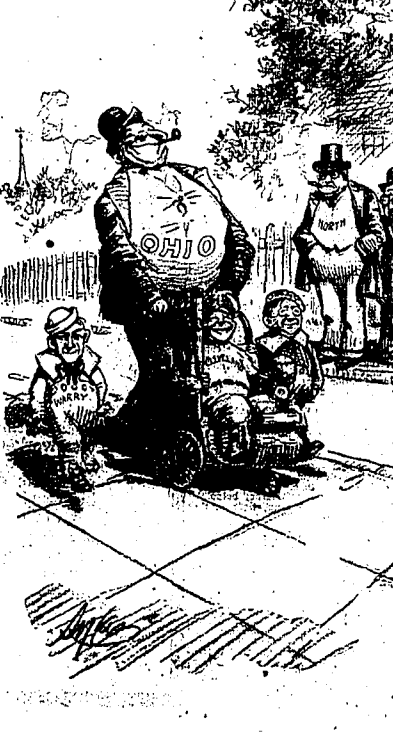

OPPOSED TO NEW DISTRICT

D. B. Moorman Fights Granting of Rights to Organize Irrigation District.

Opposition to the creation of an irrigation district to water land in the Blaine high country is being made by D. B. Moorman, president of the Murrumbidgee Canal Company.

Mr. Moorman, in a statement made public this morning, said that his company considered it highly inadvisable to organize a district of the kind and attempt to put bonds on the market to secure money for construction purposes.

Mr. Moorman's company had 1200 acres under water, he asserts, before the first bill which is planned to irrigate Blaine area. Twenty-four thousand acres would be included under the second bill, which the president of the company proposes to submit later.

Construction of a power plant is proposed now, he says, which will produce six to ten million kilowatt hours a year or two before making a permanent investment.

Formation of the district has already been made with the approval of G. W. Swenson, state reclamation commissioner. Organization of the district will be reported with the secretary of state at Boise. Mr. Swenson will appear before the county commissioners in the morning. Tuesday afternoon to explain his attitude toward the proposed project.

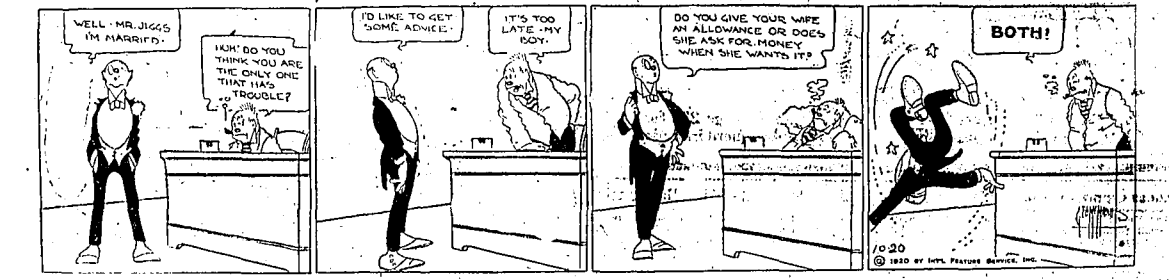

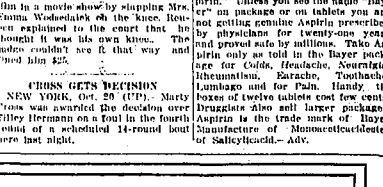
