The Turkish army, under the command of Kemal, has advanced upon the Greek positions. Prince Andrew, brother of King Constantine, and many high officers including the commander-in-chief were left among the slain. Some School Election Facts

- 1. The election will be held in the high school auditorium from 1:00 o'clock to 3:00 o'clock next Friday afternoon, April 8, 1921.
2. All resident taxpayers having the qualifications of voters under the general laws of the state of Idaho may vote.
3. In the case of married persons, both husband and wife are qualified to vote even though the husband is a non-resident of the town or city in which the election is held.
4. It will not be necessary to register in order to vote.
5. The purpose of the election is to secure the approval of the qualified electors in the district in the matter of making an additional levy of 20 mills in order to raise sufficient money to keep the schools open until the close of the school year.
6. The additional levy will be made in August, 1921, when the annual regular levy is made.
7. One-half of the tax raised by the additional levy will be payable in January, 1922, and the other half in July, 1922.
8. A very small factor involved in the election has to do with the salaries of more than 100 teachers who have voted by the district and stuck to their jobs without drawing a cent of pay since December 22, 1920.
9. Another great factor in the election involves 3200 school children, each of whom has a half-year of school work at stake.
10. The largest graduating class in the history of Twin Falls—one hundred, sixteen young men and women— anxiously awaits the verdict to be registered at the polls next Friday. How great the obligation of the district is with respect to these worthy young people is inestimable.
11. The schools will close if the election fails.

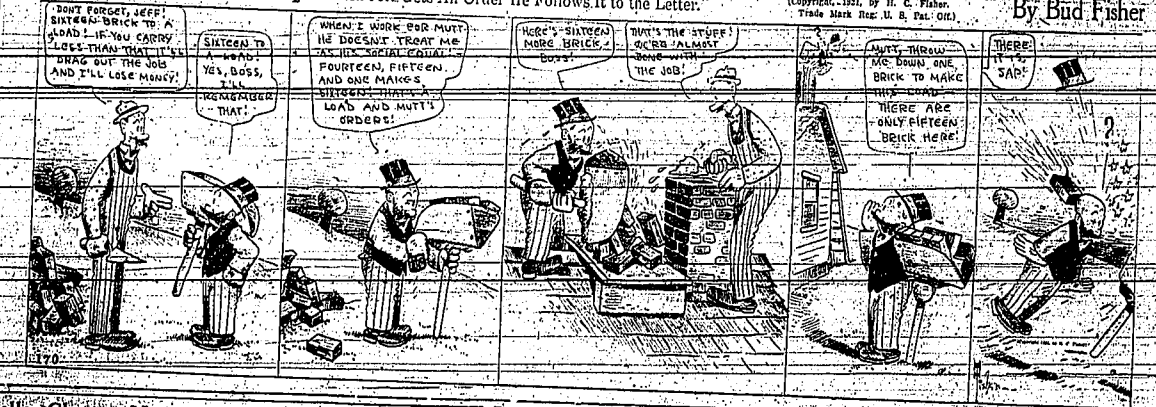
