Anticipate Greater Reducing Crop
On Third Session of Texas Last Season

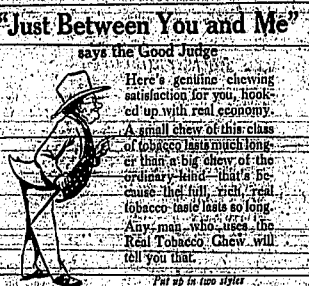
