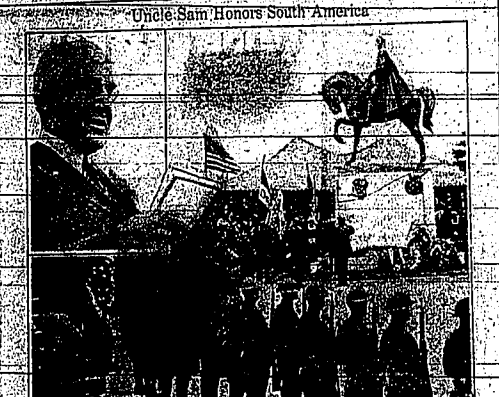

# FARM BUREAU SEED LOANS BLANKS HERE

**Management Explains Circumstances Regarding Conditions Which Explain May 1**

Additional blanks for seed loans have arrived at the farm bureau headquarters and the management is confident that they will be distributed to those who need them at once at the time of the first of the month. Following is the statement of the local bureau:

The national blanks apply to the purpose of giving the farmer and the amount for which application was made was smaller than the amount for which the farmer was privileged to participate in the application.

Examples in the farm bureau office show that 25 applications were made, but only 10 were filled. The remaining 15 were either on or off of the books. There were 100 blank loans and in all but two cases those who were selected were on the ground that their crop yield for last year was greater than 5 bushels to the acre.

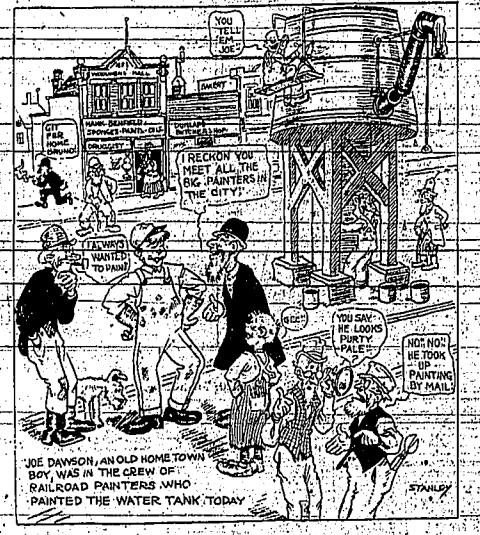
