

High Post Blocks Plan to Exchange Arcana, Ticket-Scalpers Get Busy With Hold-ups.

NEW YORK, May 23.—Tex Rickard received official permission to his Dempsey-Carpenter spectacle in Jersey City July 2 but he is not worried.

Just a little delay at the printer's shop where the New Jersey state commission is having a new model H-crate built, has prevented the official from handing Rickard the key.

The streak is more than half built and it was better to concentrate the contractors as they will turn the plant over to Rickard about June 15.

Demand for tickets has been so heavy that Rickard called the contractors in to talk over an enlargement of the stadium that would make it big enough for 100,000 spectators.

Lambert has been doing a little bookkeeping since the contract was awarded and when Rickard found it would cost him four dollars each to build some five-dollar seats he called off the plans.

Cash in hand in Rickard's bank is now at the three-quarter million mark and he is naturally pleased with that. The receipts were excellent, the Dempsey-Wildcat sale very few choice seats are now on sale at Madison Square Garden.

But tickets have been grabbed by scalpers. They were even later to a bid of \$100 for a \$50 price of admission.
