



Chairman Lasker of the U. S. Shipping Board has asked congress to authorize him to get rid of the wooden ships built during and after the war, by sinking them. He says that congress should share the responsibility with him, but that if it refuses he may sink them on his own responsibility.

At first blush, the Lasker proposal may seem extremely radical, but the more one analyzes the modern ship situation, the more he realizes since there seems to be in the proposal.

Those ships cost the American taxpayers between \$20,000,000 and \$100,000,000.

Their construction was one of the great mistakes of the war. It was undertaken at a time when everybody was more or less panic-stricken because it looked as though German submarines were going to win the war.

Now the shipping board has these hundreds of ships on its hands, and there's absolutely no use for them. Many of them are unsalvageable because they're built of green lumber. The best of them cannot compete with the best type of wood ships. And the steel ship market is glutted to the extent of making a loss.

It is costing about a million dollars a year for warehouse and caretakers to look after these wooden ships.






