

The building of the new fish hatchery near Salmon is progressing rapidly.

Idaho will this year produce 267,000 tons of sugar beets, 60,000 tons of hay and 10,000 tons of alfalfa.

Farmers and merchants of Grangeville have incorporated a bank-like institution with a capital of \$25,000.

The irrigated wheat fields of Whitworth county are producing a wheat crop this year of 25 bushels per acre.

Otto M. Jones, Idaho state penitentiary, finished in second place in the 100-yard dash at the annual track meet at the opening of the new state penitentiary.

Frederick Whitworth, 3-year-old son of Dr. and Mrs. F. H. Whitworth, was drowned last Friday in Lake Pend Oreille near Shoshone Falls, Idaho.

Idaho has a two-thirds bushel crop of potatoes in the state this year according to federal agricultural statistics.

The Unconsolidated Mining Co., which has property near Idaho Springs, is the richest of a large body of radium-bearing ore.

Preparations for the coming of the harvest of all crops in the state are well in hand in Idaho as the weather is being moderate by Robert H. Pratt, state health officer.

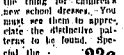

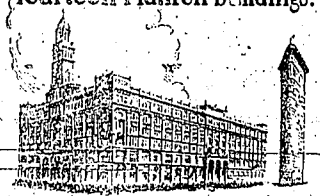
