Miners Want Martial Law— for Own Protection, Said

MADISON, W. Va., Sept. 1.—Efforts to recruit a large body of former service men to fight union miners marching into Logan county failed here today.

A meeting of the American Legion to effect defense organizations was held here today at the executive mansion of Governor MacClenan. The Legion, which had been organized yesterday, held a meeting at the state capitol, and the members marched in procession to the state capitol, and the singing of "We'll Hang Dan Chaifin to a Sour Apple Tree."
