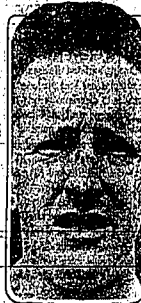

Minimum prosperity means housing of the poorest citizens. It is, saying that "there is not a family in the town with an income below a thousand dollars."

Mrs. Gilman presents a constructive suggestion when she declares that "a great social service can be done by developing a sample town." This should appear to be an ordinary industrial community, some new factory and its employees placed where it could have communication with the rest of the country. It should leave an impression on the surrounding community. The people here would not work for the adjustment between "imposed" and "desired" supplies.

The only study of Mrs. Gilman's article reads less in the specific suggestions she brings forward than in the fact that the article is sympathetic. It means that the woman of the United States and of other civilized countries also is hereabout to be reckoned with as a builder of the city beautiful.

International as well as industrial peace can only be attained in proportion as we are capable of understanding and controlling human nature. Following culture of insanity in 1911, which plunged the world into war, an attempt has been made by statisticians or diplomatists at the peace conference to discriminate between the signs of sanity and insanity.

Judging sanity and insanity is a biological and not a psychological problem. It is not a question of body and mind, but of body-mind. The organizations of body-mind in sanity provide: (1) channels for discharge of energy in action, (2) which individuals to face specific problems of actual life, and (3) reveals effort by definite signs of achievement and feeling of satisfaction.

Bohemianism, radicalism and the tendency to think in terms of class distinction are defense reactions of imbeciles afraid of facing their own personal problem.

Success of individual, future of democracy and the fate of our civilization depend upon the recognition of these biological principles and the cultivation of mental processes favorable for sane thinking and acting.
