The federal government will bid Idaho people to market their large potato crop this year by establishing a market here in Idaho Falls. This paper will publish daily reports from this market as soon as it is opened and send the readers of The Times fully informed on a market which is much larger than usual in Idaho but we understand it is almost 40,000,000 bushels short throughout the nation.

If the Blue Jacket grade can be put in shape for anything like \$7500, as has been suggested, it will be a great bargain for both countries. We hardly agree with those figures and feel that it will cost more nearly \$50,000 for each county concerned to establish the grade they wish to build it as well as it should be. When you come to blasting heavy rock and working down the grade, such an undertaking becomes a real task. But it is worth doing, regardless of the cost.

Every effort should be made to reconvert (Thomas) Sugar, who spent half before last from the county jail.
