Twin Falls will be governed by the city commission form of government just as soon as an election can be called, and a new set of officers chosen. The campaign worked pretty warm for the last two or three days of the election. Those supporting the commission plan had most the best organization and the result was by a substantial majority. Those opposing the commission plan put up rather a poor campaign and lacked a thorough organization earlier enough to make their work count.

The suit filed last Friday against the Warren Construction company on our paving had a great deal of influence on the election and perhaps more than any other one thing won for the commission plan supporters. There is no doubt that Twin Falls was handled a package in the paving bid here and the present city council did not approve of the job altogether, yet in this election it was made to appear that they had accepted same without protest.

Homer L. Mills is a clever organizer and takes advantage of every opportunity to make capital out of every point in the campaign. Mr. Mills is the man that is responsible for winning this election.

The commission plan is not a bad plan of government and we understand that Boise has been governed under this plan for several years. It has some very commendable features and others not so commendable. One of the features which the winter favors is the prohibition of handing people to the polls or to register. The result with a small number on the petition is not so desirable but if good sound business men are elected to office and they stick to their knitting that may not be used to much detriment in this city. This new plan will make it possible for the people on petition to initiate legislation. We shall watch this new form of city government with much interest and if I convinced that it is better than the old plan we shall support it in the future.

## DAIRY FACTS

### HARVESTING SUPPLY OF ICE

Few Tools Are Required on Average Farm and It Is One of Least

Paying Crop

Reported by the United States Department of Agriculture

Washington, D. C.—The supply of ice available for harvesting purposes in the United States is estimated at 1,000,000,000 bushels. All that is required is a supply of ice and a little care. Natural ice can be harvested on farms where soil is soft and the snow is present, but where the soil is hard and dry, the ice must be cut with a pick ax and then hauled to a storage house.

The first thing to do is to provide a place to store the ice. If ice is scarce or hard to get up, it would probably be well to build an ice house for storing the ice. If there is no room for this, the ice can be stored in a basement or garage, and hauled to it with an sled or sledge. If this is done 20 to 25 per cent additional labor should be provided to allow for shriveling.

Ice houses should be built to contain at least one ton of ice per cubic yard. For cooling hills, allow 1½ tons per cubic yard.

These quantities should be enough to have a large family for several months.
