JAKE SCHAEFER WON CHAMPIONSHIP IN BILLIARDS

He Defeated Willie Hoppe Last Night
Is the Third Block of the Tournament
for the World's Championship

CHICAGO, March 28—Young Jake Schaefer equals the world's 125-billiard-block champion today.

He defeated Willie Hoppe, former 125-blocker, by 141 to 130 points, changing the record from 125 to 140.

Hoppe was the final block last night and Schaefer won by a margin of 44 points as a result of the play of the two previous blocks.

Hoppe had the better average each

block and while Schaefer averaged 45 12-1 to the entire contest Hoppe averaged 45 23-5.

Willie Hoppe was characterized as "the most brilliant player in the world" in his match, but he wasn't so game as his 10 year old daughter, Alice, tried to be.

The tiny golden-haired girl, after missing the first few hours of billion play, which kept her up all night, edged constantly, rushed to the stage again as the play had ended and well as she could, congratulated the former champion on his third showing.

They give as a treatment the inhalation of pure oxygen, followed by a stimulant.
