## SMUGGLERS OF DRUGS SOUGHT BY OFFICERS

**Contract Opium Valued at \$2,400,000 Is Being Bought by New York Officers Following Arrests of a Number of Sub-pats or Dope Sellers.**

**NEW YORK, April 7.—**Smugglers of contract opium worth at \$2,400,000 involved in a huge drug smuggling conspiracy were sought here today by federal authorities following raids last night on opium-smuggling houses occupied by dope sellers were made.

Men already in custody are suspected of being members of a firm which includes a number of well-known underworld characters. The value of the opium was estimated at \$2,400,000 pounds.

## BRUM'S "BUM STEER"

(By JAMES D. WHEELAN)

President Illes of Uruguay presents nothing new in suggesting a commission instead of a single individual as executive head of his nation as published recently in the Times. The matter was much discussed in the convention which drafted our constitution and was the subject of a great deal of eloquence when that historic document was before the country, the foes of the single executive head urging that he would become a tyrant.

The manifest fact that singleness of purpose is necessary for effective execution was a sufficient answer to that proposition then and is now. And in some way this will be brought about. In old Roman times there were nominal triumvirates, where there were boards composed of three men, but sooner or later through a natural process of elimination it got down to one man. If it did not, the wheels would not go around.

Casar, Pompey and Crassus formed a triumvirate, unofficially. The Parthians relieved the stress, by killing Crassus, and Cleopatra ended the trouble by overthrowing Pompey, after which the government functioned. Anthony, Lepidus and Octavian formed a legal executive board in Rome, which ended when the latter became sole emperor, and again the machinery went around.

Napoleon once said "One bad general is better than two good ones," while Wellington more aptly declared that an army might make a shift to get along with a poor commander but could not exist under a debasing society. The same is true of all executive places. A governing commission in a Latin American republic would mean a repetition of what took place in the Roman republic. Regardless of what might seem to be the case, nominally, there would be but one loss. Division of responsibility, as usually pointed out, has been the prolific source of corruption in American politics, and I am not loctering my commission form friends after their recent victory because I repeat it. To extend it to the executive would make the chief magistrate hopelessly inefficient.

There should be some constitutional changes properly made in America. The supreme court should, as proposed at the time of the constitutional convention, be authorized to determine what state courts are permitted to do, for legislators in some states, namely, advise congress in regard to the constitutionality in advance of passage of vital legislation. Where more than one third of the supreme court agrees that for a definite reason, a measure properly passed by majority of both houses and duly signed by the president is unconstitutional, that particular law should not be set aside by a "five to four decision." Lastly, in case of a dead-lock caused by a veto of a bill, or by a single house standing in the way of the other house and the president on a specific measure, the two houses, or the president accompanied by the one house whose legislation is blocked, should be permitted to appeal to the people.

In other words, we want more action and efficiency, not less. Our system of checks and balances is unfortunate, and may yet be eliminated.
