

LABOR SAVED IN HARVESTING HAY

Good Methods, Efficient Management and Proper Implements are Essential.

USE HORSES FOR HEAVY WORK

Small Groups Need Not Make Large Investment in Hay Apparatus

Economical to Use Horses for the Large Lots.

Proprietary to the United States Department of Agriculture.

Much labor is wasted in harvesting hay, not necessary because of the use of good methods, inefficient management and improper or imperfect implements are employed, my specialists of the United States Department of Agriculture say.

The use of a mechanical hay bale is shown, they say, methods must be adopted by which the greater part of the heavy labor is done by the team.

In the summer of 1919, awakening early once since, in July, 1921, was being handled on the hill by a thread of men, several teams of horses, old assistance being two apprentices of 20 years.

Time of harvesting is important. The more the hay is harvested the sooner it is dried, the better the hay is.

The amount of hay made per acre is based on fresh hay bearing on the amount of hay made per day and the number of men required. This is especially true on farms where there is no power equipment available in the afternoon only.

If harvesting is done in the morning and raking in the afternoon, more men and horses than usual will be required, and the cost will be increased. If harvesting is done in the afternoon, still more men and horses will be needed.

The five-foot cut is the most common.

It is the easiest to handle and economy to use larger horses; also, seven and even eight-foot cuts can be used on a great many farms. Some idea of the time saved by using the larger cuts is given by the following differences in the amount of work done by each in an hour:

Under average conditions, a five-foot mower will cut ten acres in 10 hours, or 10 acres in 12 hours; a six-foot, 12 acres; and an eight-foot about 10 acres in ten hours.

It is evident that more power is required in the cutting of larger cuts.

The five-foot cut is the most common.
