## BRITISH CLASH WITH FRENCH AT CONFERENCE

**Great Britain Serves Notice on France That She Must Not invade Germany or There Will Be Trouble Between Them; War Cloud Hangs Over Geneva.**

**FRANCE'S Objections to the Aligned "ultimatum" note to Russia, today caused another day's delay at Geneva.**

"The note prepared by allied experts was ready for consideration by the political committee of the conference," said a spokesman. "It proposed a counter-draft. Britain is said to have waited in this matter."

"France's note provides for the following points:

"An ultimatum note to Russia.

"A detailed method of procedure whereby requisition shall be made for private property of foreigners in Russia.

"A preamble covering financial aid which will be granted the soviet government.

"An explanation of the workings of a financial consortium in which England, France, Italy, Holland and Sweden are to participate.

"A preamble calling for a new régime of foreign trade.

"An Italian plan for reorganization of the Black Sea.

**Much Discussion of Note.**

**British Servicemen in France**
