N.Y. Governor's Stand Spurs Both Sides to Activity

In Putting Name to Measure, New York Governor Emphasizes Necessity of Abiding by Existing Laws; Advocates Volstead Law Modification.

NEW YORK, June 2.—An army of federal prohibition enforcement agents was mobilized today to be thrown into New York in support of the governor's action in approving repeal of the enforcement act results in a bonus rebellion in this state.

President Harding in a recent letter to a citizen of Newburgh, N. Y., stated that the consequences would be disastrous if any state permitted violation of the prohibition law, and strongly hinted that the federal government would take any state and take over control of dry law enforcement if necessary.

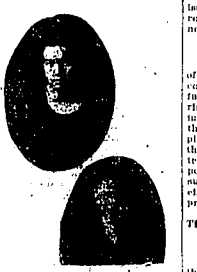
