Otto H. Kahn Refutes Idea That Foreign-Finance Activities Dull Allegiance to America.

BANKING REFLECTS BUSINESS

"International Farmer" and Other Markets Now Who Sell to Foreign Bankers Create Demand for International Financial Service.

The idea that bankers engaged in financing foreign trade and in handling foreign bond flotations are a part of the "international bankers" actuated by motives sinister from those of other bankers was refuted recently by Otto H. Kahn of New York in an address before the Rochester Chamber of Commerce.

"There is no such thing as an 'international banker' in America, as the meaning of the term is generally understood," Mr. Kahn said. "He exists in the imagination of people all over the world but does not exist in the fact."
