#### TRADE SHOWS IMPROVEMENT

Reports to the Federal Reserve board covering business conditions during the six weeks ended October 31, show that whole-sale trule was the largest in three years, that retail trade increased 9 per cent over a year ago, although the seasonal increase of summer business was smaller than usual, and that production of basic commodities declined. Interovenent was maintained at the high level of the last several months. There was also an increase in contract awards for business and industrial buildings. Due to the decrease in contracts for residences, new building construction as a whole, however, showed a reduction as compared with the

Distribution of all classes of commodities by the railroads con tinued at a high rate in September and early October. This condition, the review points out, reflects the increased wholesale and retail trade as well as the heavy stocks held by retailers at the end of September.




