The magnitude of the Boy Scout movement, the fourteenth anniversary of which will be celebrated in February, is hard to realize. The movement enrolls over 100,000 boys and men, a number which is constantly increasing. It is estimated that three million boys have been identified with the movement.

The Boy Scouts of America anniversary activities have a great appeal not only to those millions directly concerned with the movement, but to the entire reading public. Last year over thirty state governors committed themselves to the scout work, and local and municipal and state officials everywhere participated in the anniversary program. LYNCHINGS DECREASE IN U. S.

One of the most encouraging signs of the times is the great decrease in lynchings during the past year, the number lynched being less than one-half of the total put together during the year 1922, according to the figures quoted for the year 1922. At a meeting of the Federal Council of Churches, in 1922, the sudden wave which swept over a large part of the country in favor of upholding the law with action by forces outside the law raised the number of lynched to 57, but the subsiding of this wave of mob-epimality reduced the number of lynched to 28, while 10 persons were saved from this method of punishment.

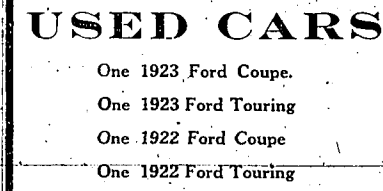
