Minidoka Appropriation Cut by New House Bill

American Falls Construction Work Eliminated from Appropriation

Bill: Minidoka Project Is Cut \$350,000 by Committee House

Bill: Leviston Land Office May Be Abolished and Other Projects Cut Down.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 10.—Carrying appropriations of \$351,765 of which a considerable part was for western reclamation projects, the Interior Department appropriation bill was reported to the house late yesterday.

Abolition of many land offices to the ground that the amount of business transacted did not justify continued maintenance after July 1, 1923, was recommended, including:

Sterling, Colo.; Lewiston, Idaho; Spokane, Kansas; Great Falls, Kalispell, Mont.; Elko, Nev.; Clayton, N. M., and Yakima, Wash.

The appropriation for the Minidoka project in Idaho, \$380,000, is \$250,000 below the current law and \$60,000 below the budget due to elimination by the committee of new construction work for the American Falls river reservoir.

REALTORS WILL PLAN TO IMPROVE LIVING CONDITIONS

Augusta, Ga., Jan. 10.—Peter H. Ingles, president of the National Association of Realtors, has accepted consideration by the national committee of the National Association of Realtors to hold a three-day seminar here Jan. 17.

Representatives of 480 real estate organizations of the United States, Canada, and Mexico will be present to discuss the problems of real estate valuation, rental conditions, real estate taxation, zoning, and real estate and general taxation.

The session will be the principal educational program of the association during its annual meeting, which will be held this year for the formulation of policies.

Dr. E. Appleyard, president of the association, will preside over the meeting for the association as recommended by the directors.



ELECTION OF SENATOR SMITH

The election of Senator Smith of South Carolina as head of the interstate committee responsible for the seating of the part of the upper chamber which bespeaks returning sanity and healthy progressive advancement. A few days ago, I had some visitors down in Harrison county. I had long anticipated the trip because Harrison county contains one of the most famous poultry centers in the middle west—and because it was in Harrison that the first state constitution was adopted more than a century ago—but the history of Harrison county identified with the past of many another county. When the land was first cleared, a few raise excellent crops of dower, wheat and corn—but their soil was exploited as all virgin soil is and, forty-fifty years, it became very unproductive.

"The southern railroad runs through this territory and about twenty years ago it put on something new—an agricultural and industrial agent. In order to make business for the road he knew that he must make the agriculture along the road permanent. His name was Carlson Held and he started the half of prosperity rolling by interesting the folks in poultry and cattle."

Harry Davis bought the first manufactory incubator in 1907. It took 5000 eggs to set it. Then others went into the business. Now there are in Harrison county sixteen commercial hatcheries that turn out a million and a half chicks a year. To supply hatching eggs for these concerns, literally hundreds of farmers are keeping poultry. I saw a great many flocks that number more than 500 hens. As near as could be estimated, 25,000 cases of eggs are shipped out of Harrison county every year. Even on that poor soil, I saw more painted buildings and modernized farm houses than I have seen in any other county in the last year.

FIND RICH GOLD FIELD IN SIBERIA

Stanovol Gold Belt Heralded as Discovery of Greater Importance Than the Klondike.

New York.—The Stanovol gold belt of Siberia is heralded as a "potential gold field of greater importance than any of the isolated Alaska or Minnesota discoveries of the last century," by Chester Wells Huntington, the noted agricultural engineer and geologist who is now a member of the American Institute of Mining and Metallurgical Engineers. Since the release of this report, the result of the research of his extensive travels, the national headquarters of the Institute say that Huntington was lost in the Tschu disaster in a vain attempt to save his two children after being shipwrecked.

Huntington's report, based on exhaustive study of voluminous literature, maps and statistics and many personal journeys and field inspections of various parts of the world, makes the conclusion that "the area adjacent to the Stanovol, Zingzhuang and Tschabon ranges is that which is most accessible to the western world and most promising afterglow for exploration."

Area Over 4,000 Square Miles.

This report, after describing the history of the region, the beginning of east Siberian mining, physical features and climate, says that the Stanovol has as other mineral deposits, asserts the existence of untraced stores of gold, saying:

"The IRKUTSK region, the latter remarking that the region described is one of unlimited possibilities. It is equally idle to expect any exploitation of the metal and mineral deposits to the benefit of individual miners, who are too few to come. The world would profit, however, that the Chukot-Ulja region at seaboard constitutes definitely new discovery of a valuable gold, which has the potentiality of containing great commercial reserves."

Considering the area already apparently of more than 4,000 square miles, without any mining, the report says, even part of the world, so far as resources go, it is found, he regards it as a potential discovery of far greater importance than any of the isolated Alaska or Klondike discoveries of the past.

Estimated portions of this field have already added \$100,000,000 to the world's store of gold assuming the major part of the world's wealth in mineral deposits and professional efforts.

Must Build Roads.

The development of Siberia, the increase of general population, the bettering of remote seas and altogether the increased ability of engineers and navigators to deal with rivers, roads and canals, will make the opening up of a very few years make the zone of the Stanovol one of the accepted fields of economic exploitation, although the vastness of the distances, the lack of roads, from the ocean through the mountain passes to the interior.

The Trans-Siberian railway has more to do with the development of Siberia than any other factor, the Southern Trans-Siberian, the Western Trans-Siberian with its connection with the Great Slave lake. So vast and so beyond the ken of ordinary transportation, the opening up of the interior of Asia, which itself is cradle of rare immensity, is yet to day being rediscovered industrially."

FARM STOCK**Potatoes Are Good Feed for Horses and Cattle**

Potatoes may be fed to live stock in large quantities, but they may be dried and fed raw or dry feed. It is best to cook them before feeding, as raw feeding of raw potatoes will cause diarrhea. Undercooked or undercooked, unboiled, unpeeled potatoes are the most economical method of cooking potatoes for live stock. Feeding investigations indicate that when potatoes are fed to cattle, the protein requirements, from 100 to 420 pounds of cooked potatoes have a feeding value equal to about 100 pounds of grain while from 200 lbs. of uncooked raw potatoes are required to equal 100 pounds of corn.

Some feeding experiments of the Oregon agricultural experiment station in 1918 showed that steaming the potato increased their feeding value about 50 per cent.

Vermont agricultural experiment bulletin No. 12 shows that the average analysis of the potato is 1.2 per cent protein, 0.6 per cent ash, 2.2 per cent protein-free extract and 0.1 per cent fat. The low protein content of potatoes makes it necessary to add a cereal ration with feeds that are relatively high in protein content.

"Dried potatoes" are sprouts of the potato plant containing condensate, soluble protein, compound, and should not be fed.

Potatoes are palatable and well suited to feeding stock, but care must be taken to avoid overfeeding. They are equivalent to about one-third of their weight in hay. When potatoes are fed, a legume hay is a desirable supplement. If it is grass hay, add a concentrate, legume hay, etc. It is advisable to chop the potatoes to a pulp, as the whole potato is difficult to digest. The protein to cereal ration should contain feeds rich in protein, such as a concentrate, legume hay, etc.

Cooked potatoes may be fed in cubes at the rate of 25 to 30 pounds per head per day, 1000 lbs. per acre, or 1000 lbs. per acre per day as a result of their tendency to produce scurving. A heavy amount of raw potatoes, however, produces milk and bitter taste of potatoes.
