FIFTY KILLED IS ESTIMATE OF JAPAN QUAKE

WASHINGTON, Jan. 15.—Fifty persons were killed in the earthquake which struck Tokio and Yokohama, Jefferson Caffery, chief of the Japanese section of the Foreign Service, at Tokio, told the State department at five o'clock yesterday.

The disaster caused suspension of the railroad service, water supply, electric lighting system and telegraph and telephone services.

Twenty-four persons were reported killed, thirty others.

The estimate of fifty deaths was made by the Foreign Service, which had no official report from Tokio, but which was told by the Japanese government that there was nothing about the Teapot leasing by Fall for the Shultz interventionists to seize upon.

IDAHO RATE HEARING IMPORTANT

It is a good idea to have southern Idaho organizations, well represented at the率 hearing January 15-16 which it is hoped to impress the interstate commerce commission with the justice, and clemency, and the magnitude of the demand for better rates in the part of the intermountain region, while at the same time opposing discrimination against the textile centers and distributing points of Idaho in favor of the coast.

Some months ago, Senator W. E.
