The irrigation program which is operating in Twin Falls will bring forth many important facts and also information which are worthy of consideration.

Shortly after the new year has opened the long spring term of school begins. Too often before we rise in May in time children and teachers are tired, worn and listless and the "blue" spirit in the schoolroom becomes a weary drag. This ought not to be the case. The school work should be so arranged as to fully advantage of the more active life of spring and make so interesting that school closing is a matter of regret rather than rejoicing.

TAX COMPROMISES PROBABLE

Washington advises indicate a net bill for reduction on the part of republican leaders that if the Mellon tax reduction measure is passed congress or any other bill providing for tax reduction is to be enacted, there must be compromises of some sort, material character.

It is felt that the tax measure to be reported by the ways and means committee is not likely to follow the exact line of the Mellon tax reduction program. It is significant that the republican leaders do not conceal the fact that there has been a very favorable reception in many quarters of the democratic plan put forward by Congressman Warner. That proposal contemplated further reductions than embodied in the plan submitted by the secretary of the treasury, while, in the main, following the lines of the Mellon scheme. It is indicated in capital city, sources that administration leaders admit that the maximum surface rate cannot be reduced below 35 or 40 per cent. It is on this question of sur-tax reductions that the republican and democratic plans present the widest variance. Reductions in normal taxes and the tax on earned incomes are likely to be approved as proposed by Mellon. The repeal of some of the miscellaneous taxes not included in the Mellon plan and urged by the democrats seems to be probable.

The suggestion of compromises is significant in that it foretells quicker agreement on a measure and final action by congress since these compromises will represent the purposes of all republicans and democrats in Congress, with the exception of course of the extreme radicals of both parties who oppose any reduction whatever in the sugar rates and favor the restoration of the excess profits tax. CLIMATE CHANGES

The climate of the United States is changing, so claims Elmer D. Burns, former weather observer for New York. Elmer Burns says this change has been slowly but surely taking place since about 1895.

Old settlers in various parts of the country frequently make the same claim, especially in the northern and eastern states. They have in mind the very deep snows of former generations, snow so deep that horses pulled sledges right over the top of fences, with drifts 10 feet deep or more.

Weather bureau officials in Washington, D. C., have disagreed. They say that climate merely moves in cycles—very warm for a while, then very hot. They check up old records and say that, if you take the weather average over periods of ten years each, the average temperature of these periods, or cycles, has never varied more than a few degrees since the first weather observations were made.

Burns, nevertheless, is living up with the old settlers. He is positive that the climate is changing, and he blames the big irrigation projects in the West. About nineteen million acres are now under irrigation. This means a tremendous amount of moisture dammed up in what otherwise would be dry country.

Water, in a dry country naturally evaporates quickly. This evaporation changes the moisture of the air and, affecting the barometric condition, generates storms which are not only local but go traveling. By this reason, we have abundant rains, floods and general freaks of weather.

Dammed-up water evaporates fast in a dry climate. In the Ohio Valley, evaporation is 10 inches a year. It is over 100 inches in New Mexico, Arizona and southeastern California.

The old settlers often mention the theory that climate has been changed by the destruction of forests, which formerly absorbed a lot of moisture and kept the snow from melting quickly.
