

SOVIET PROPAGANDA

Under the usual resolution the United States Senate is continuing an investigation to determine the truth of the claims made by Senator Lodge that the Russian government freely distributed and backed propaganda in the United States to further its form of government in the hope of setting up another socialist. Denial has been made that the Russian Bolshevik government was behind the propaganda.

There has been a strong suspicion in this country that the Russian radicals have been unusually active in America. Testimony given before the investigating committee tends to prove this. A. W. Steele, a state department official testifying before the committee that the workers' party of America, guided by the Russian third international, ordered its members in March, 1920, to undertake propaganda in the American Legion and the army and navy with a view to inciting arms and ammunition for armed revolution against the American government.

These orders were issued, the witness said, as the result of instructions brought to the workers' party from Russia by the head of the third international, Compton Phipps who is still said to be in the country. Present Russian officials, Zinovjev, Blumkin and Radec, were officers of the third international at the time William Z. Foster, a radical worker, received large sums of money from Moscow to help to lead the third international propaganda in America.

Drunkens with power in Russia, the Bolsheviks apparently thought they would revolutionize the world and they considered America the land of a free people and free institutions, fertile ground for their radical ideas. In this they were mistaken. America wants nothing to do with Bolshevik doctrine but that does not disprove the fact that these agents of Lenin were active in spreading their propaganda in this country. Capital News.

LUTHERAN CHURCH AND THE KLAN

The regular Lutheran church is not identified with the federal council, but its attitude may be judged by the context of a pamphlet entitled "Weighed and Found Wanting—An Inquiry Into the Alma and Methods of the Ku Klux Klan," circulated by the American Luther League, which quotes the following conclusion to quote its closing words:

"The framers of the constitution were generous, far-sighted men, who extended the privilege for citizenship without such distinctions as are essential to the Klan. They would not look to a secret band of adepts to uphold and defend what they had built. They would have shamed with indignation the discriminating measures of an self-appointed tribe led on as a bodyguard for the degradation of independence and constitutionalism."

The Klan, it is true, asserts that it wages war on an American citizen's race, color or creed or political affiliation. This is heretofore. The discriminating methods which the Klan adopts are a secret, if not an avowed, attack on a large number of our citizens. The Klan's influence on our public life cannot be either that divisive and disintegrating. The Klan cares less for the Union. It exists today, for its own special ends within the Union. All its oratory on the noble aims will not blind thinking Americans to this unhappy feature."

To sum up: the Klan must be considered an ominous phenomenon in American social and political life. The rise and spread of this mysterious organization is well shown by thinking Americans with grave concern. All American citizens should, therefore, carefully consider the issue which has been created in our national life by the rise and spread of this mysterious organization. Must we actually commit the ideals and institutions of our republic to the hands of the Ku Klux Klan for safe-keeping? and would they really be safe in the hands of the Klan?
