PARIS, Feb. 7.—Lloyd George, premier of Great Britain, today denied the charge made by the French press that he had signed a secret pact with Wilson, president of the United States, before the latter's departure for France.

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WILSON'S FILES MAY BE USED TO SETTLE DISPUTE
