HAS SKULL OF A DINOSAUR

Museum of Natural History Exhibits Bones of Huge Extinct Rhinoceros-like Animal.

The American Museum of Natural History has recently placed on exhibition in the foyer the skull of the famous "Diplodocus." This enormous extinct rhinoceros-like animal found in Mongolia by the Third Asiatic expedition.

The skull was found in the Tazgan Nuru district, on the northern side of the mountain, and was transported on camel back over a thousand miles across the desert of Gobi to Kulang, the ancient railroad, thence by rail and steamer to New York, says the Scientific American.

It arrived at the museum still partly buried in coarse sandstone. The rock was chipped away carefully, the broken parts were glued together, weak or shattered parts strengthened, and the missing parts restored in plaster which is colored and finished to match the skull.

One side of the skull is mostly restored, while the other side, which is nearly complete, as a model. Of the original skull only the upper jaw (maxilla) and the remainder was restored from the jaw of a related but somewhat smaller genus.

Iowa Testing Law Aids

Fight on Tuberculosis

One of the most encouraging factors in the fight against cattle tuberculosis, according to those in charge of the work, is the fact that the United States Department of Agriculture, at the insistence of state legislators, in passing laws to facilitate the widespread testing of cattle in selected areas, a broad program of testing has been adopted this year by persons of greater importance than the testing of individual herds at random. A state law which could make perfect excellence is that passed in the spring of the Iowa legislature.

Brady, this Iowa law provides that on petition of 10 per cent of the owners of cattle in a county, the state live stock sanitary authority of that state must proceed to eradicate tuberculosis from the county as provided in the law, and that the state will furnish the petitioners a monthly payment in the amount of 12 per cent of the value of the animals to be tested, a portion of which the owners of breeding cattle will pay for the county testing, all the hard costs in the country must be tested and a due and full account will be provided separately for those who do not turn over their animals to the test.

In case the county cannot levy and the state and federal funds are insufficient to meet the cost of testing, the state will furnish the county with funds for a tax of 25 cents a head on all cattle and 5 cents a head on all hogs in the county.

University Farm Testa

Rationing for Baby Beef

About two hundred Minnesota cattle raisers at University farm recently received a copy of a pamphlet giving practical directions for feeding calves to each other when cattle are taken to market. 
