The great victory for William G. McAdoo in the South Dakota primaries, following his triumphs in California, in Georgia and other places ought to be enough to make those who up to now assume that the people lack intelligence enough to discriminate between a lawyer who acts in an open and honorable way for his client, and a public servant who betrays his country. In South Dakota, McAdoo ran for ahead of his foes, who opposed disunion. His candidate for United States senator got a 3 to 1 vote over the anti-McAdoo candidate early returns indicate.

There seems to be quite a sentiment in this state in favor of abolishing the Idaho utilities commission because of the fact that this body seems to continually render decisions in favor of the corporate interests of Idaho and against the ordinary citizen. The proper sort of a utilities commission is essential but in many states this body has become the football of political trickery and the men who go to make up this body are not sufficiently versed in the issues before them to render a decision worthy of the dignified office to which they have been nominated.

In some respects a terrible pull seems to have overcome many of the residents of Twin Falls. Regardless of what in the cause there is no call for such a feeling. Business may not be quite as brisk as it has been but there is nothing to get the blues over. Everything points to the best year in the history of Twin Falls and to hear because the railroad to the south seems to be either temporarily or permanently tied up its fully of the worst sort. The question of the future growth of Twin Falls is not entirely dependent on whether we get a railroad to Nevada. We can make a wonderful city here without any sort of a railroad. Automobile trucks can compete with the railroads in freight and passenger traffic and there is no need of getting down in the mouth because we had hoped and hoped that the Oregon Short Line or some other concern would build a railroad from Rogerson to Wells. The future of this city is largely up to us. The way we think determines our future, so let's set our feet on a firm foundation and then we can build here a great city. We have at our very door almost 40,000 prospective shoppers and yet we are not doing our utmost to sell them in Twin Falls. Let's go as the Jews often say and if we will all go out with that spirit we will make a much better impression than we are in our present status.

OLD GANG VICTORY: DEMOCRATIC OPPORTUNITY

The old gang won at Lewiston a much more sweeping victory over Senator William Edgar Borah than it won at Coeur d'Alene four years ago, so far as our surface indications go. As that time, the majority of the American Legion against John W. Hart, for ambitious actions during the war, that parliament was elected national committee, to succeed himself, as the one condition of harmony in camp laid down by the senior senator. This time Hart has retreated before John Thomas, right-hand man of Senator Frank H. Gandy, and one of the most ardent and formidable foes of Senator Borah. The Borah victories seem to consist in forcing an instruction, or instead of an endorsement of President Coolidge, thus preventing the Idaho delegation from joining up the president and getting anti-Borah votes in exchange for the votes of the delegation; the defeat of the previous resolution, and election of the senior senator as a delegate with the same sort of general approval in the resolutions that were rendered to other members of the delegation. Borah figures that the bonus bill will be in force before election either with or without the presidential signature. He can go before the people in this event and ignore this issue. But a probulous resolution at this time by a republican state convention would carry with it a rebuke that might embarrass the senior senator. The defeat of this resolution, therefore, was a great Borah victory. Whether the senior men will, instead of accepting this withdrawal for the senior senator, hold the defeat of their resolution against the whole party in the state of Idaho remains to be seen. For weeks it has been known that the Borah and anti-Borah men had agreed to bury the hatchet for the campaign, and it was only in tactical matters that the quarrel continued. Legally it was never holding in support of the things for which the old gang stands when this support is needed. He will swallow his defeat, since his enemies have swallowed him and all will go into the fight for the interests.
