WEEKS TURNS RECORDS OVER TO COMMUNIST

WASHINGTON, April 4.—Secretary of War Weeks today transmitted to the senate the investigation committee all war department records in the case which the committee demanded yesterday. Weeks sent them to the committee by Captain W. P. Volant, assistant chief of the finance section of the air service, and requested that all but one of them be considered by the committee in secret.

When the committee convened in open session Chairman Brookhart announced that Weeks had sent all the records desired by the committee at this time and that Captain Volant would be retained in executive session later today.

Brookhart also announced that the committee had decided to hold hearings on the new issue at Washington, D. C., on April 10, to examine the records of the National Security Council, which is the committee's latest move to get the former attorney general, to stand.

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Sue Tariff-Protected Firms as Monopolies

WASHINGTON, April 4.—Suits began by the government against the general Electric company and two other large concerns charged with conspiracy in regard of trade and attempts to establish a monopoly in their field recall that these corporations are among several which the republican sixteenth congress "protected" by high tariffs while they were either being investigated by the department of justice.

The General Electric company, the Westinghouse Manufacturing company, the Westinghouse Lamp company, now accused of violating the Sherman anti-trust law, are the beneficiaries of heavy duties placed on practically all kinds of electric materials, supplies, and manufactures, including lamps.

Since John Fordney-McCumber law was enacted in 1922, suits against other of the principal beneficiaries of its exorbitant "protective" duties have been attacked or pending on charges of illegal practices. The Algonquin Company of America, in which Secretary Mellon is interested, is now a defendant in an action brought by the federal trade commission, which alleges that this corporation is a monopoly. This is the second time the aluminum company has been before the courts on similar charges.
