

RILROAD COMMISSION TAKES STATEMENT TO U.S. COURT

Full explanation of the present situation which has resulted in the delay of the raising of \$15,000, which will start tomorrow, is contained in a statement issued today and filed in the full railroad commission, following the understanding arrived at yesterday with E.
