THOS. JEFFERSON, CONSTITUTIONALIST

The eloquence in regard to Thomas Jefferson, the anniversary of whose birth will be celebrated "tonight" in the Jefferson club here, adds no "great political philosopher," to the words of Senator Borah, has earned many well meaning people to look upon him as a mere theorist instead of the greatest practical statesman of his age. Without doubt, the school of privilege has striven to create the impression that Hamilton was the greatest factor in drafting the constitution, and the implication has even been given out that Jefferson opposed the "adoption of that immortal instrument." Unfortunately, many liberals of insufficient information who admire Jefferson, and many radicals who would set aside the constitution, accept these fallacies and strengthen the arguments of the exponents of monopoly.

As a matter of fact, Jefferson and his friends favored the adoption of the constitution, with the assurance that a bill of rights would be added and the first 10 great amendments voice the Jeffersonian spirit. Jefferson was in France when the constitutional convention was held. "Hamilton's talk in the meeting were no more influential than that really exerted little influence. Madison was "Father of the Constitution."

The supplementary amendment which was intimated in a letter from Jefferson in which he said, "The constitution is a most curious on a few strokes only needed retouching. I am not of the party of the federalists, but I am much further from that of the anti-federalists."

Instead of being in favor of overthrowing the constitution, Jefferson favored strict construction in order that not merely the spirit but the letter should remain intact. His denunciation of this principle in the case of the Louisiana purchase may only in seeming, since he desired a constitutional amendment to ratify it, and his followers would not let on his suggestion, so we had the territory without the amendment.

In spite of this, there is a widespread belief that Jefferson favored the idea that the courts should give effect to all laws passed by Congress regardless whether they believed them unconstitutional or not. This is not true.

In a letter to Judge Spencer Roane, dated October 12, 1816, Jefferson said: "I hope our court will never countenance the keeping of pretensions that have been set up under the words 'common defense and general welfare'."

He added that he had taken this view when the question was first raised and that his opinion in this regard had been confirmed by 25 years reflection and experience.

Of course, Jefferson with reason opposed judicial usurpation as a great possible menace. Moreover, he favored calling a constitutional convention every generation, to keep the fundamental law of the land up to date, but probably realized the value, to the cause of liberty of a stable construction of the meaning of the organic law more than he.

In fact, history shows absolutely nothing, in order to insure for all time the great principles for which Jefferson stood. These principles were summarized 15 years ago by J. A. F. Chandler of Richmond, in a biography of Jefferson as follows:

"Jefferson stands in history for, republicanism, government and the sovereignty of the people; opposition to privileged orders of nobility and the entail system; universal education and local civilizing; liberality; separation of church and state; freedom of thought and speech; local self-government; economy in government and small public debt; a policy of peace; equality political and universal suffrage; strict construction of the constitution and the sovereignty of the states; well trained militia and small standing army; metallic money, either gold or silver, as a standard, and no paper legal tender; opposition to bounties and monopolies; emancipation and deportation of slaves; expansion of the United States to include Louisiana, Florida, Cuba and Canada; maintenance of Indian reservations; judiciary beyond the control of the legislative or executive branches of government; small navy; opposition to deportation; return in office; opposition to all secession movements, north or south."


