Most any one can sit back and yell "Sick 'em" when some one else starts the fight but the thing to do is to get in and "Carry on" if you are dead in earnest for the cause. The American people as a rule lack backbone and we find some of this in Southern Idaho but if we are to clean up affairs in this state we must stand firm against the things which we believe to be wrong and contrary to proper jurisprudence and we can never overcome the evils which exist in our state or our nation.

The writer had occasion to visit Burley and Rupert recently, and while there found that the outlook for crops this season were very favorable. The people of that part of Idaho state that they will have plenty of water to mature their crops and the sub-irrigation has started in the neighborhood of Rupert about three to four weeks in advance of the regular time for this sub-irrigation season. This is indeed encouraging and we believe that the so-called water shortage will not prove nearly as big a menace to southern Idaho as a good many folks had originally anticipated. As a matter of fact experts inform us that more water is used by about one-third than is best for the maturing of a crop. This is especially true of sugar beets.

The Twin Falls schools have closed for the summer, but the boys and girls should not be allowed to forget that the price of scholarship is eternal study and good reading. Many boys and girls who have been too busy in the past to pursue a course in music should take up something of this kind for the summer. They, too, they should be encouraged to patronize our public library. Many excellent books are on these shelves and the summer time is a splendid time to pursue a regular course of reading. We would like, in speaking of the library and its store of books, we would like, to say in passing that the city folks might do worse than to appropriate a thousand or so dollars for new books to replenish the shelves with some new literature for the coming generation. An investment for the future generation is worth while and we are inclined to spend so much of our money for other things rather than for mental development that this should not be overlooked.

PLENTY OF WATER IF JUDICIOUSLY USED

Every four or five years there is a shortage of water on the Twin Falls tract, and it was to guard against consequences which might be involved in an extra short year which followed the short year of 1919, led the equal board to sign up for approximately 100,000 acre-feet under a proposed enlarged American Falls dam; an amount later subscribed for under the big district project.

The short year is here and the dam is still unconstructed. It, therefore, behoves the people of the district to face the situation and apply the supply of water on hand in such a manner as will prevent any undue loss from lack of sufficient supply, or at least from lack of quantity to which they have been accustomed.

Two things should be kept in mind. One is that for as possible this season crops of a kind requiring little water should be planted. The other is that no more water should be used than is necessary for the particular crop under irrigation. The Twin Falls tract will this year have more water than has been judicially determined as being sufficient for the Salmon tract, though it may be added that a number of Salmon settlers contend that jurists are apt to know more about how than about practical irrigation. Some of the greatest seed crops, with almost fabulous profits were raised on the Twin Falls tract during the short year of 1919, and to a lesser extent during the other short year of 1919.

While the Twin Falls tract has none too much water on the average, and while the subscription for 100,000 acre-feet will under the American Falls dam was part of wisdom, there can be no doubt that in many cases more water is used on particular crops than is needed or even than is good for them. On a year like this experts tell us that it is part of prudence to see that no more water shall be used than will produce the maximum return, even though it shall require some extra labor cost to apply the water scientifically. There is plenty of labor to be had on the tract today, and where the difference between careful irrigation and careless irrigation is likely to be as great as it seems possible at present that it will, the greatest care should be exercised. When there is an abundance it is an easy matter to turn the stream loose and let it go, with just enough care to keep it from flooding the roads to badly, and while this is not the practice of many, it has been of a few, who will learn the lesson of economical use of water by experience which may profit them in the future.

Most root crops like beets and potatoes and some seed crops like beans, can get along as well or better with fewer, shorter surface irrigations than with flooding, and will give better returns with less labor than under the flooding process.

The chances are that the net return of the Twin Falls tract will be as great or greater this year than last, and every effort should be made to get the maximum net return.
