WOMEN TO GO TO COURT

Democratic Platform Presents Progressive Remedies for Nation

Resolutions Committee Report Accepted Which Does Not Mention Klan by Name Accepted by 14 to 16 Vote in Committee; Pledges Freedom of Religion; Freedom of Speech and Press; Minority Report May Bring Klan Issue to Floor of Convention; Balloting for Nominees Starts Tonight.

MADISON SQUARE GARDEN, New York, June 28.—A plank pledging the faith of the democratic party for maintenance of "freedom of religion, freedom of speech and freedom of press" was presented to the democratic convention by its resolutions committee this afternoon.

After a bitter fight the committee decided to accept the plank not mentioning the Ku Klux Klan by a vote of 34 to 16. The plank as adopted read:

Freedom of religion; freedom of speech; freedom of press. The democratic party reaffirms its adherence and devotion to those cardinal principles contained in the constitution and the precepts upon which our government is founded, that congress shall make no laws respecting the establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof, or abridging the freedom of speech or the press, or the right of the people peaceably to assemble and to petition the government for a redress of grievances, that the church and the state shall be and remain separate, and that no religious test shall ever be required as a qualification for any office of public trust under the United States. These principles we insist and we expect to defend and maintain. We insist at all times upon obedience to the orderly process of the law and deplore and condemn any effort to use religious or racial distinction.

Minority Report on Language. To the democratic national convention. The undersigned, a majority of the committee on resolutions, themselves unable to agree with the plank, submitted the following report, entitled: "The League of Nations."

The most important problem facing the nation of the world today is how to secure from the past and remove the menace of future wars. The only hope for world peace and for economic recovery lies in the organized efforts of sovereign nations cooperating to remove the causes of war and to substitute law for violence.

Under democratic leadership a practical plan was devised which calls for the free cooperation of all nations in the work for peace. The sovereignty of the United States for the last four years has had no economic recovery. The cause of this is the political and economic aspects of the world. This plan was devised which has outlined our foreign markets and raised our agricultural production.

It is of supreme importance to civilization and to mankind that America be the first to take the lead in the greatest moral question of all time and to establish a democratic party renews its declaration of confidence in the ideal of world peace, and its belief in the possibility of justice as against constituting the cause of war and to substitute law and religious conviction of our time to organize the world for peace.
