BUTTE, Mont., July 11.—One thousand acres of valuable timber was destroyed in 24 hours by a fire which is still raging in the mountains of Montana.

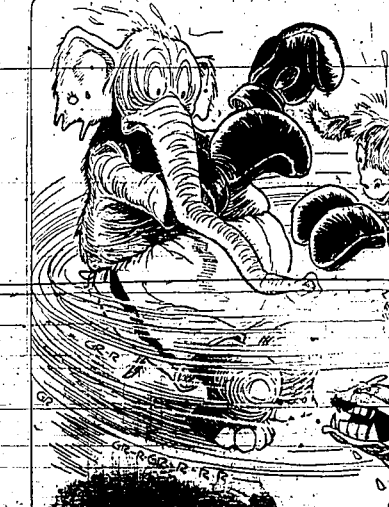
Wife Is Shot Down in City of Love

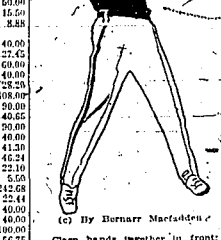
