Brazil, from her southern frontier, does about the best work of the Rio de Janeiro, the capital, is largely a negro country along the coast, and a trackless jungle in the interior.

To the southwest of the Rio de Janeiro latitude live white men mostly first class soldiers from northern Italy, fighting Germans, quite a few English, rather fewer North Americans, a scattering of Scandinavians, and a few others.

Southern Brazil, in short is by no means a good deal more Argentine than it is. Brazil has a magnificent geographical adjoin Argentina.

Southern Brazil, the present spot of the New World, has the half-hearted government of the northern Brazilian states. It's only a question of time before it falls into the hands of the United States.

One of two things may happen: Southern Brazil may join Argentina, or it may establish a republic of its own.
