In the boozey-haul-in-the-westend-country, the sheriff's office showed itself up to its usual high standard in enforcing the law in this country. Without beating of tom-toms or sounding of bugles, Sheriff Finch has made good in this county during his term.

The Chamber of Commerce in assuming relations with the United States Chamber of Commerce is getting in touch with the commercial body movement of the country. The meeting, presided over by T. J. Lloyd, vice president, gave careful consideration to the whole subject before acting.

With the zeal of the proselyte, Samuel Gompers has thrown himself into the election contest without waiting to hear the interpretation put upon the democratic platform by the nominees. His sole argument against Davis is that the latter was employed as a lawyer by the Morgan syndicate. The same argument was made against McAdoo who was employed by the oil syndicate as an attorney. Neither did anything but perform their duties as lawyers in an honorable way. Yet Gompers was for McAdoo.

The city commission in connecting with the state sanitary department in the matter of inspection will not impinge the inspection, which was already of the highest and most effective kind, but it will be able to deal more thoroughly with outsiders who may desire to evade the previous regulation inspection. At the same time, the cost to the city will be lower than would otherwise be the case. Farmers acting legitimately under this department have shown a disposition to co-operate with city inspection in the past, and only occasional, sporadic peddlers from the outside have shown a disposition to duck the activities of the officer. Local dealers have been always willing to co-operate with this department, since the fact that the meat was certified is always an asset worth having.

FORD DREAMS OLD STUFF

Henry Ford, interviewed in Collier's Weekly, proposes that the United States could make future great wars impossible by arming itself with invincible strength. We'll be the policemen walking the beat with a big stick to keep order.

Nietzsche had a similar idea and sold it to the Germans.

The direct result was the World war.

Nietzsche in effect told the Germans: "There can never be lasting world peace as long as there are powerful rival nations with opposing interests." The most powerful, just and deserving nation (the superstate) should arm itself until by conquest it would be able to conquer the rest of the world and put all nations under one flag. Then there wouldn't be any rival left to fight. Hence—lasting peace."

Sounds logical; doesn't it? The Prussians thought so. Their leaders followed the Nietzschean philosophy.

Many Germans claim, and sincerely, that Germany really built her great war machine to keep world peace—that she had no original intention of going to war with Nietzsche's idea of trying to put the whole world under one flag.

But as soon as a nation gets a powerful military organization, she tempts to use it. Confidence of her power she "takes up" from nobody. Like pistol-toying by the individual—it inclines him to a chip-on-the-shoulder mental attitude.

This was true of Germany.

It is true of all nations.

Henry Ford is a patriot. Quite naturally, he believes that his country, America, is more just and noble and altruistic than any other nation—in fact, that we are the only people who can be trusted with super-military power.

The rest of the world doesn't think so. Every other country has the same notion about itself. It's this hollow-chest-thou attitude.

Until nations get rid of this attitude that "I'm the only fair and honest gent in the crowd," there can be no international brotherhood. A police system must be by mutual agreement, not by self-appointment.
