G.O.P. BUDGET IS \$3,000,000 BUTLER SAYS

Major Part of Amount Is to Be Used for National Campaign, According to Chairman of Party in Inquiry—Testimony.

CHICAGO, Oct. 17.—The campaign budget of the republican national committee total three million dollars, William E. Butler, national chairman of the Senate congressional investigating committee here today.

Of that sum \$2,500,000 is to be used for the national campaign and the balance in the congressional and senatorial campaigns, Butler said. Cash collected up to the present time totals about more than \$1,000,000, he said.

"Very much more is to expect to collect between now and election day," Senator Borah, chairman of the committee, added.

"All of it," Butler replied, "three million dollars."

Denies Soviets Send Money to Help Campaign

EN ROUTE WITH SENATOR LA POLETTI TO BOISE—Maurice La Polletti, independent candidate for president, today denied charges by T. V. O'Conor, chairman of the shipping board, that money is being sent from Russia to help the Bolsheviks buy the Little-Wheeler ticket.



BOISE TOURIST PARK POPULAR

Total Registrations for Past Summer Reach Large Figure.

BOISE, Idaho, Oct. 17.—The total registrations in the Boise tourist park during the 1924 season amounted to \$300,000, the board in charge announced. Due to the fact tourist travel is falling off it was decided to close the park this week. During the month of June, July and August, a total of four cars averaged 70 daily, with from two to five persons to the car, so that the park was filled to capacity.




