MINNOKA BANK ROBBER GIVEN LONG SENTENCE

Albert Engstrom, Twenty-two, Sentenced Today for Daylight Robbery of Minnoka Bank; Others Still at Large.

(Special to the Times)—RUBERT, Nov. 28.—Albert Engstrom, a youth of 22 years, was found guilty early Thursday morning of robbery of the First National Bank of Minnoka, November 7, and was this morning sentenced by Judge T. Bailey LeB to serve from five to 20 years in the penitentiary. The other two burglars who were connected with the daytime crime are still at large.

In his testimony young Engstrom claimed he spent the afternoon on which the robbery was committed in Rupert and at 215 P. M. there it is alleged the three men entered the shooting pool in the first pool hall in this city. Witnesses said he was in the pool hall about half an hour, after which he went to the Palace cafe, where a little later three of these men and their associates took a taxi and drove to the river where he killed a doctor; then went to a football game. Asked on cross-examination if he saw anyone else he knew witness mentioned names of several whom he knew as being there.

John Kidd, an inmate of the Minnoka county jail, put on the stand by the prosecution, testified that in the holdup in which he said that he had taken the car to Rupert about 11:00 o'clock on the day of the robbery, then went to the country where he borrowed a gun, went to Arvada and got some shells, and from there to the river where he killed a doctor; then went to Minnoka and stopped at the shooting pool. He was then taken to the cashier and robbed the bank. Engstrom, Kidd said, told him he filled his pockets with money, and after leaving the bank had fired several shots back from the rear window of the car from the town where in a deep ravine the car was abandoned and he had thrown the gun and shells away, split up from the others in the car and started home, carrying his money to a place near the project where he planned to hide it.

Engstrom, while on the stand, denied the story of Kidd, saying he had only told the witness why he was in jail and that the pool hall was identified at the preliminary.

Five witnesses were put on the stand Tuesday by the prosecution. Some Albert Engstrom, son of the proprietor of the Minnoka pool hall, and E. O. Martin, an employe, testified that they saw Engstrom at the pool hall at the time he claimed to have been there. 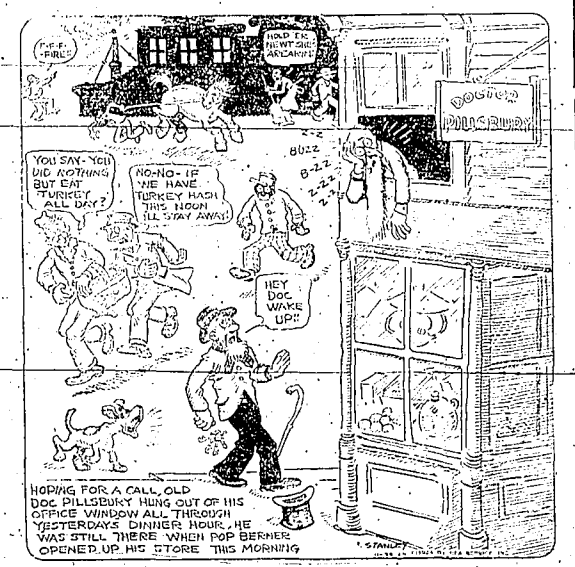
