



However, now a plan has been formed which, while encircling and linking up the city, leaves the ancient imperial parts untouched. From here it will follow the Corso, Umberto to Piazza Colonna, and after passing Piazza Barberini swerve to Via XX Settembre and Via Nazionale as far as the principal railway station ending near the Church of St. John Lateran. The preliminary terms for the concession have already been agreed to and a contract has been signed between the Royal High Commissioner, Senator Filippo Cremonesi, and a Franco-Italian company. The company will have to provide a capital of 10,000,000 live within four months, and may later therease it to 40,000,000. The Commission of Archaeology has secured the right of all execuations and discoveries found during the work of construction.


