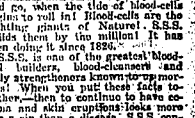

Now an international anti-bluffing and anti-obscenity conference is being called, and the king of England sends his ambassador to notify the Italian government of his hearty approval.

If this keeps on, even sobriety may become fashionable.
