Boosting is contagious. Try it on your neighbor the fine qualities of your home community, about its superiorfor dairying, sugar beets, stc., and see how readily he tees with you—how he enters into the spirit of the conation, and the first thing you know both of you are feaming with the thought that the "old home" community is pretty good place after all. Knocking has the opposite effect; if you don't believe it, try it. Join a group of men any day, where one of them takes on the role of the "crepe hanger," and although some of the listeners feel that the gloom hanger is telling the truth, they will enter into the spirit of the conversation only half heartedly. You wouldn't permit for one moment anyone to knock your family, your stock, or your farm—still you would be silent if the country was referred to. We are all one big family, and we ought to have the same consideration for our home community that we have for our families and

Boosting is so contagious, so easy to acquire and does much good when it finally spreads, that all of us ought throw ourselves in the path of the germ and become noculated with it. The after-effect is so pleasant, that he whole community ought to become exposed.

We raised 13, 280 tons of beets on 1000 acres of land and they will bring at the present price of beets, over \$100,000, of which 85 per cent will remain in the community as most of the labor was done by children and local help," says Leonard Ball.

"We also grow potatoes and grain as well, keeping a good per cent of our land in alfalfa so that sheep and stock may be fed on the land to help keep it in a high state of fertility. The alfalfa is broken up and potatoes put in, then follows two or three years in beets, then seeded back to alfalfa. Thus making a rotation that keeps the land in a high-state of cultivation.

"We also have a cheese factory running full capacity, as our farmers have learned that there is money in a few good cows on the farm to help make a market for the hav and by-products of the sugar beet.






