## IDaho FAILS TO RATIFY CHILD LABOR MEASURE

**House of Representatives Defeats Measure Today After Long Bitter Debate; Vote Stood 38 Against and 18 for the Amend-**

**ment.**

**BOISE.** Feb. 7.—Idaho was added Saturday to the list of 16 states which have rejected the national child labor amendment. The house defeated the resolution for ratification by a vote of 38 against and 18 for the amendment.

The measure was introduced by Rep. John C. Collins, of the city.

Collins lost his bill, however, and the measure will be seriously considered on Monday.

Collins' bill No. 57, the "prime-time conservation act," regarded as of prime importance in the administration's program.

Of a dozen new bills introduced by Collins Saturday, the following will be seriously considered on Monday:

House Bill No. 127, enabling com-

munications commission to ac-

cquire immediate funds for educa-

tional institutions; improvements

provided for in the three third-

year bills; and a bill No.

128 if that passes.

House Bill No. 318, making it a

crime to practice dentistry without

dentists' license to minors.

House Bill No. 329, increasing the

maximum weekly compensation

for the disabled constable, but al-

lowing him to keep the sum of \$450 a

month; holding valid claims against

the state highway fund, which

is to be used for the construction

of roads, bridges, etc.; and a bill No.

330 if that passes.

Passage leading to Collins' re-

opened debate today after having been

adjourned since Wednesday following the introduction of the measure.

Dr. P. J. Baker, leader of the Pasadena Rowellites, was made defendant in court action, initiated by his for-

mer wife, Mrs. James Wells of Olden College, who has filed a suit for \$1,000 damages, alleging Baker "has

been guilty of wilful and wanton

negligence in his conduct of the

business of the church."



### NOME AND THE ANTI-TOXIN TREATMENT.

With the swiftness of light, the radio brings word of the diphtheria epidemic in Nome; but even if airplanes can be found for part of the journey, the needed anti-toxin will be tragically slow in arriving.

Many will die because we cannot flash the physical remedy through the ether, as we do the news.

On the same day, the incorporation is announced of a new "anti-visitation" association, for the promotion of laws to prohibit the manufacture of antitoxin.

Thought is free. If anyone chooses to believe that the earth is flat, that twice two is five, or that antitoxin does not control diphtheria, there is no way to prevent.

But such persons are not entitled to be taken seriously by those who know better.

Least of all, should the law impose compulsory conformity to their fantastic notions, at untold cost in human life and suffering.

It is questionable whether liberty of thought includes the right of personal suicide, and it certainly does not include the right of wholesale murder.

Society is entitled to the protection of modern knowledge, even if there are atavistic, anti-scientific medievalists who choose to close their eyes to the facts.

### NOTHING ABOUT HORSE RACING

Bills have been introduced in Missouri, and presumably in other legislatures, to "restore horse racing."

The curious thing is that these bills have not a word about horse racing in them.

There is no law against horse racing in Missouri now, and the proposed bill has nothing to permit horse racing.

The only thing it authorizes or regulates is gambling. It should be entitled "A Bill to Legalize Gambling." Whenever horse racing gets into the hands of horse racers, who want to race horses, for people who pay admission to see horses race, it will be time to talk about "restoring horse racing."

Any bill which has nothing about horse racing in it is not a horse-racing bill.
